I am writing you on behalf of [REDACTED].

modus operandi, sensitive operational info

The transfer of [REDACTED] to the detention center of Gjader, in Albania, is currently ongoing.

The persons concerned were already serving an administrative detention in Italy, meaning that all of them have already received a return decision and a detention order, followed by a validation by the relevant Courts.

The operation is taking place in the framework of the bilateral agreement between Italy and Albania.

Law-decree 28 March 2025, n.73 has amended Law 21 February 2024 n.14 (about ratification and enforcement of the bilateral agreement between Italy and Albania) and the Immigration Law, creating the legal basis for this activity.

The center of Gjader will be therefore used as a national detention center, for the purpose of the completion of the procedures related to identification and return.

We hope to be successful and, if so, this could be the first of many similar operations in the future.

In this light, we would like to understand if the activation of EURP assistance for the migrants concerned could be a feasible option in this scenario.

While waiting for your answer, I take the opportunity to thank you for the cooperation that we constantly receive from your Division.
